The ConnectED Library Challenge, a campaign promoted by the Institute of Museum and Library Services, is a challenge to communities throughout the country to create or strengthen partnerships so that every child enrolled in school can receive a library card and have access to the books and learning resources of America's public libraries. The initiative calls upon library directors to work with their mayors or county executives, school leaders, and school librarians.

In addition to partnerships that improve library card access, participating libraries also commit to:

- Support student learning through programming that develops language, reading, and critical thinking
- Provide digital resources, such as eBooks and online collections of traditional media
- Provide broadband connectivity and wireless access within library facilities

The Falls City Library & Arts Center will join in this “challenge” for all area students. Stop by the library front desk to pick up a library card form and get a free bag!
